

Important announcement from outdoor Mass on Saturday, Oct 3rd 2020

Dear St. Anselm Community,

Please be advised that St. Anselm Church received a report that a family that attended our **outdoor mass on Saturday, October 3**, has had three members subsequently diagnosed with COVID-19. We have notified the Sudbury Board of Health. We have also cleaned and disinfected all of our equipment and seating used during the Mass.

As the Mass was held outdoors and all attendees were wearing masks and socially distancing, it is unlikely that anyone would have been in “close contact” with the infected individuals. We followed all health requirements which included: no congregational singing, no passing of a donation basket, distributing Holy Communion in specially marked areas after mass, Communion was distributed without passing of breath and priests wore masks as well, no responses to prayers by congregation, no social gathering before or after Mass and everyone brought their own chairs. We are issuing this notice, however, out of an abundance of caution.

Anyone who may have attended the outdoor Mass on that date should consider contacting their own physicians for guidance.

Thank you for continuing to be vigilant about the importance of social distancing and wearing your mask at all times. Please continue to bring your own chairs to outdoor Mass Saturday.
