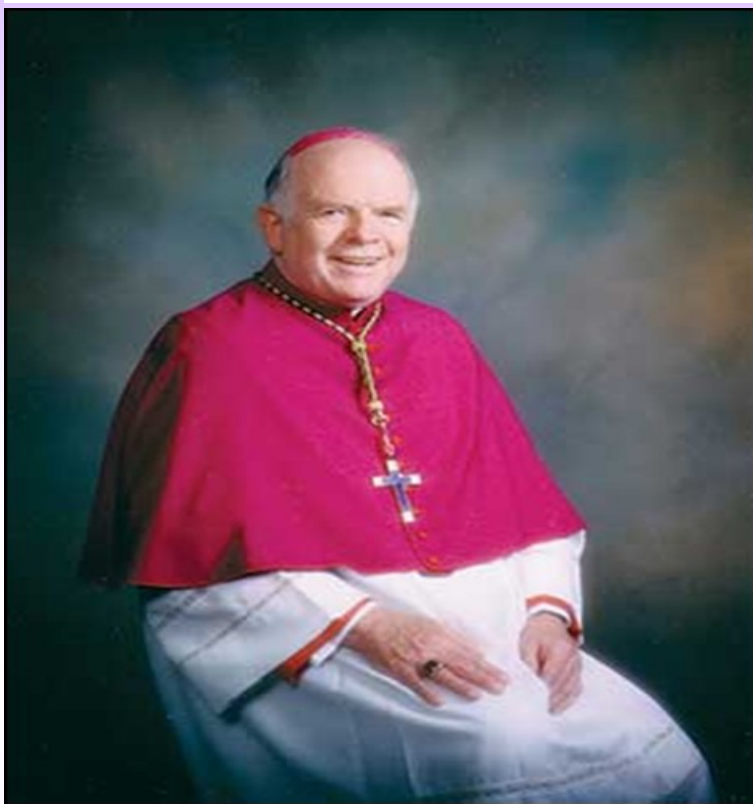

Bishop Flesey obtained his Doctor of Theology Degree from the University of St. Thomas in Rome in 1990. In addition, Bishop Flesey holds a Master's Degree in Counseling from Iona College, N.Y. Bishop Flesey has spoken widely on a number of topics related to spirituality, both nationally and internationally, and has published a series of recorded lectures on preaching and the scriptures which were produced by Alba House. The topic of the mission will be "The Gospel of John, Identity and Mission."
