What is the garage sale for?

Is there a deadline to sign up to sell items at the Garage Sale?

Yes, September 1

Where will the sale take place?

On the church grounds facing Landham Road. You can sell your items at a table or out of the back of your car. We encourage sellers to bring their own table, but we will provide some tables on a first come, first served basis.

What can I sell?

Household/kitchen goods, sporting equipment, small furniture, children's toys, games, etc. If you would like to sell clothes, they need to be clean and no undergarments or socks.

What if I have a few items that I would like to sell, but not enough for a whole table?

You can add your items to one of the established sellers' areas as long as they are priced.

Who prices the items for sale? Who brings the items to St. Anselm?

You do! All items should be priced and brought to St. Anselm at 7:30am on September 9.

Who collects the money during the sale?

You do! Cash and Venmo accepted. **Please remember this is a fundraiser for St. Anselm and all proceeds go to the church.**

What do I do with the items that don't sell?

Those items do need to be taken home with you. There are number of charities that we can recommend that accept donations.
